WEATHER

EAST COAST

The Georgia growing region is looking at a mostly sunny and dry week, with highs in the high 80s and lows in the 60s.

WEST COAST

The growing region of California will see a sunny and dry week, with high temperatures reaching the low 90s, and lows in the low 60s.

MEXICO

Mexico's growing region is expecting a cloudy week with a chance of storms throughout. Highs will hit the low 80s, and lows will rest in the low 60s.

FRUIT

APPLES

Supplies are light as the apple market builds with demand, putting pressure on pricing. Quality is good.

BERRIES

The **strawberry** market has improved, but quality remains fair. **Blackberries** are light due to demand with improvement expected in mid-October. **Raspberries** are steady and quality is good. **Blueberries** are steady and quality is excellent.

GRAPES

Green grapes are in lighter supply but are still good quality, with supply improvement expected in October. **Red** grapes are in high supply and of good quality.

PINEAPPLE

Pineapples are light in supply but are of good quality. Consider sizing flexibility.

AVOCADOS

The avocado market is steady, but the new crop is lighter. Quality is good. Consider sizing flexibility.

CITRUS

Limes are light due to crop region transition, and weather in impacting volume, but quality is good. The **lemon** market is expected to stay light in the near term and quality is fair to good. **Oranges** are tight and quality is fair, skewing larger. Consider sizing flexibility.

PEARS

Pears are in steady supply and quality is good.

STONE FRUIT

Peaches are winding down as nectarines finish up. **Plums** are plentiful. **Kiwi** is improving as the season progresses.

WATERMELON

The watermelon market is winding down with cooler temperatures, but quality is still good.

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VEGETABLES

ASPARAGUS

The asparagus market is extremely light, impacting price. Expect improvement in October. Quality is fair to good.

BROCCOLI

Broccoli is light due to insect pressure, with relief expected over the next week. Quality is fair.

CARROTS

The carrot market is steady in supply and of excellent quality.

CELERY

The celery market is steady and quality is good.

LETTUCE

Romaine and romaine hearts are in steady supply and of fair quality. **Tender leaf** is steady and of fair to good quality. The **iceberg** market is tight due to disease pressure, and quality is fair.

POTATOES

Larger potatoes are limited as crops transition. Consider lead time and sizing flexibility. Quality is good to excellent.

TOMATOES

Rounds are improving in supply and quality is good. **Romas** have tightened but are good quality. **Grape tomatoes** are light, but quality is good.

BELL PEPPERS

The bell pepper market remains steady in supply and quality is good. Changing weather may affect this.

BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Brussels sprouts are tight due to insect pressure, and quality is fair.

CAULIFLOWER

Cauliflower supplies are still tight due to production gaps and insect pressure. Expect conditions to continue in the near term.

CORN

The corn market is steady in supply and quality is good.

ONIONS

The onion market has tightened due to lower yields, but quality is good to excellent. Consider sizing flexibility.

SQUASH

Squash supplies are tight as crops transition, with improvements expected in mid-October. Quality is fair to good.

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
